Field Day 2013—June 22-23 WARC Planning Already in Progress

Matt KF0Q, chairman of the Operating Activities Committee, has already challenged the committee to begin planning for Field Day 2013. As you may know, ARRL Field Day is the largest on-the-air operating event in Amateur Radio. It draws tens of thousands of radio amateurs to the airwaves each year, bringing new and experienced ham radio operators together. Field Day is a radio operating activity, educational event, and public demonstration...all rolled-up in FUN!

The Winona club has actively participated in FD for many years and has received great support from local agencies and organizations which are supported by the club's emergency communications capabilities--the City of Winona, Winona County, the Winona Fire Department, Sheriff's Department, Emergency Management Coordinator, the Red Cross, and others.

The club has also received support in the form of Field Day site visits from elected officials from the US House of Representatives, the MN House and



Senate, Winona County, City of Winona, and several Winona County townships.

Recent educational demonstrations have included Amateur Radio TV, microwave transmission capability, data-transmitter balloon launches. APRS

capabilities, and other facets of the Amateur Radio Service.

Matt has suggested that there may be an opportunity to focus on a "Get-On-The-Air" station for 2013.
